Dr. Kramarz is an Associate Professor at the University of Toronto's School of the Environment. She also serves on global advisory groups, including the United Nations Development Programme's External Advisory Group for Energy Governance. She has published books, many academic articles, and has regularly contributed to media on environmental politics.

The talk will focus on some often-overlooked impacts of the renewable energy transition, particularly the socio-ecological displacements caused by critical mineral extraction. It will contrast the triumphalist clean energy narrative with the realities of dispossession, degradation, and dependent development in critical mineral producing states.
